The membership reviewed the minutes Judge Flower asked if there were any corrections. Hearing none, Judge Flower asked for the motion to accept. Jody Brandenburg made the motion to accept and Gloria Crawford seconded.

Octavius Holliday provided an update on case process through SAO. He will reach out to A.J. Mack to set up a sub-committee meeting before the next meeting in early October. Two clerks are currently working on pulling cases and he expected to have a list of cases by the end of the week 9/17/21. The sub-committee would also include Gregory Patient, Karen Murillo, A.J. Mack and Cindy Chambers.

Judge Flower introduced Chad Corcoran from Senator Bean's Office regarding the "glitch bill". Chad spoke about Sen. Bean's bill and a legislative aide is drafting it. Chad agreed to speak with Karen Muillo and Cindy Chambers to ensure the exemption mirrors that of the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team.

Gregory Patient noted a good portion of cases are tied to neglect. There was some discussion about the need to include exploitation as well because many cases are seated in financial exploitation.

Jody Brandenburg recognized the passing of Tommy Hazouri and gave an update as to the services to be held at Hardage-Giddens Legacy Lodge Chapel and Mandarin Presbyterian Church.
