- **1.** You must have been convicted in the Fourth Judicial Circuit (Clay, Duval, and Nassau counties) of a <u>felony</u>.
- **2.** You must present a plausible claim of <u>actual innocence</u> (you did not commit or participate in the crime charged).
- **3.** The claim must be supported by information or evidence not previously litigated before the original trier of fact (jury or judge).
- **4.** The claim must be capable of being investigated and resolved, and if substantiated, would bear directly on the issue of innocence.
- **5.** The direct appeal has become final, the mandate has issued, and there is no pending state court litigation.

The Conviction Integrity Review Division ("CIR") <u>is not</u> reviewing lawful sentences. The CIR <u>is not</u> reviewing affirmative defenses, claims, or information/evidence that were previously considered and litigated before the original finder of fact (jury or judge). For example, we will not review self-defense claims.

conviction remedies, such as filing an appeal or post-conviction motion. You need to pursue those
